



2021 Horse Report

In 2021 PARD owned and Operated with five horses:

- Doc, a 26 yo Quarter Horse gelding
- NuBuck, a 25 yo Haflinger cross gelding
- Bobby, a 22 yo Arabian gelding
- Stormy, a 26 yo Quarter Horse gelding
- Frank, a 22 yo Warmblood/Quarter Horse/Morgan cross gelding

Doc worked consistently in the Wendon Hills and Pard program for the 2021 year. He is fit and healthy but aging. There is no reason he cannot continue to work, but some effort should be put forward to start looking for a replacement for him.

Nubuck had unexplained weightloss in the beginning of the 2021 year, but gained over the summer and has had no continued issues with that.

Bobby is thriving on a soft food diet and senior feed. Currently his weight is the best it has been, but his teeth will continue to be a problem for him.

Stormy has suffered from some back and/or hock pain during the past season, which was seen with heavier riders on him. Otherwise he is fat and healthy

Frank was struggling with left hind pain which was lightly investigated. Wendon Hills chose to cease using him for their purposes, but he works happily in the Pard program.

All boys are aging, some thought needs to go into what will happen if one needs to retire and when a replacement option should be looked at.
