COVID-19 PROTOCOLS

The safety of our riders, volunteers and visitors is paramount for PARD Therapeutic Riding. These protocols have been developed based on the guidelines set out by public health officials and medical experts and may be amended at any time. Please do not attend if you have COVID-19 or feel ill or have symptoms including fever, cough, difficulties in breathing or are awaiting results of a COVID-19 test, or have travelled outside of Canada within 14 days, or have had contact with someone who has or is suspected to have COVID-19.

Visitors refers to anyone attending the event as a volunteer, coach, spectator, participant, or otherwise who does not live on premise.

1. Upon arrival, Visitors must pass a health screening check, sign a COVID-19 health declaration/waiver and leave contact tracing information. Information gathered for contact tracing will only be used by public health officials to inform guests who may have been exposed to COVID-19.
2. Practice physical distancing at all times. Be mindful of those around you and give plenty of space. When a physical distance of 2m cannot be maintained those able to wear a mask are required to do so. All volunteers are strongly encouraged to wear a mask at all times.
3. Attendance at an outdoor event is currently limited to 100 people. Participants may be accompanied by a coach, and a parent or guardian if a minor. All other spectators will be admitted based on attendance numbers.
4. Please bring water for your horse, if possible. This will avoid congregating around troughs. If not possible, contact a show volunteer for assistance after you arrive.
5. There will be no BBQ on site this year. Beverages will be available for purchase along with individually packaged snacks (eg chips, granola bars, etc) and provided by volunteers wearing gloves and masks.
6. There will be portable toilets for public use with frequent cleaning/disinfection throughout the day. However we ask that you clean any surface you touch for the next guest.
7. Hand sanitizer will be provided and you are encouraged to use it frequently throughout the day. Supervise young children and ensure they use it properly.
8. Horse trailers/vehicles should be parked in accordance with physical distancing guidelines, allowing for a minimum distance of 2.5 m between trailers.
9. Ribbons will be awarded by volunteers wearing masks and gloves and have been individually bagged weeks prior to the event.
